Research Instruction Offerings Summary
Summer 2020 (COVID-19 Period)

Library information literacy instruction during summer 2020 was impacted by all courses being offered online to slow the spread of COVID-19. Three librarians were embedded in 12 courses during the summer of 2020, a decrease of 25% compared to the summer of 2019 when librarians were embedded in 16 courses. Half of the sections were offered by the Clarksville campus, while the other half were offered during summer session III at the Ft. Campbell campus.

Librarians were embedded in seven online graduate courses -- four in Leadership & Organizational Administration, two in Mathematics & Statistics, and one in Music. The other five courses were for undergraduate students and included two courses in Political Science & Public Management, one in Leadership & Organizational Administration, one in Sociology, and one section of APSU 1000, the first-year seminar course.

In addition, the Education Librarian participated in two orientation sessions for middle college and dual enrollment students via Zoom, providing an introduction to library research and resources.
